


Our Time on Earth

Loan fee; framing, vitrines, and exhibition stands; crates; audio visual equipment; objects; rights clearance and licenses; texts in English in a printable digital format; advice on layout and design; and advice on installation and removal. All AV equipment and hardware travels with the show. All rights cleared for content.

Number of staff travelling for install/de-install

No more than seven staff for 14-day install and seven staff for 7-day de-install (venue to cover cost of transport, accommodation, per diems, and visas).

One member of staff may need to stay for at least the first two weeks of the show to maintain, train local staff and ensure all machines are kept fully operational at all times (venue to cover local accommodation and salary).

Transport

We request that one way (incoming) transport is covered by the venue. The exhibition travels in a maximum of 4×40 ft Hicube sea containers (TBC).

Please note that Barbican touring exhibitions can only be reserved through formal contracts, letters of intent and payment of a deposit.
