Dance An exhibition to engage the body!

The Dance exhibition puts our visitors in touch with their bodies as they experience a joyful, creative, spontaneous and original visit. It offers the chance to enjoy dance together, in a way that is accessible to everyone.

In this family-friendly exhibition, visitors embark on a journey to discover a variety of dance styles from around the world. They can watch, imitate and experiment with different movements while observing themselves. In many contexts, or simply when hearing music, we dance spontaneously, almost naturally. Dancing is an immediate and liberating action.

Dance comprises various different facets. It plays a role in children's development, of both mind and body. Dancing helps us to become aware of our body and to learn to control it while liberating ourselves from it. It allows us to express our emotions. Dancing is about using our bodies to create, from our little toes to the ends of our hair.

Four action verbs shape the exhibition. They comprise three essential actions, central to dancing, and a fourth action for taking the time to think about the dance experience: turn, jump, come together and rest.

HIGHLIGHTS

Mash-up videos: universal, trans-historical and multi-cultural montages.

• Digital tools: original installations for visitors to interact with the exhibition.

• A choreographed dance invites visitors to join in every 30 minutes.

The dance installations are designed in collaboration with dancers and choreographers.
